Photo Consent

Data Collection

I grant to the University the right and the right to authorise others to make the Recordings available across all platforms and all media (in whole or in part, transcribed or otherwise) in perpetuity throughout the world for the non-commercial educational and promotional purposes of the University, such uses including but not limited to print and online publication and broadcast, e.g. in websites and social media sites such as YouTube, Facebook and Twitter.

Internet Access

This child will be visiting Cambridge University Engineering Department for work experience and will be under 18 years of age at that time. To participate fully the student will need to be given access to IT facilities provided by the department, including access to the Internet.
